

Regular Council Meeting
City Hall, Mansfield, Washington
March 11, 2026

Mayor Wall called the meeting to order at 6:00PM.

PRESENT: Mayor Wall, Council members Lamar, Bayless, Lester and Tupling. Supt. Mark Doyal, Clerk Sima, Joanna Scheibe, Keith Siebert, Sheriff Tyler Caille.

UNEXCUSED ABSENCE- Council member Jardine.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE- Pledge was led by Mayor Wall.

MINUTES- Council member Lamar made a motion to accept February 11, 2026 minutes, Lester seconded, motion carried.

14TH CONTRACT AMENDMENT, INCREASED DISPOSAL RATE-CONSOLIDATED DISPOSAL- Clerk Sima presented information to the council regarding the increase from Waste Management. Council member Tupling made a motion to accept, Lester seconded, motion carried.

RESOLUTION 2026-6-ESTABLISHING RATES AND RULES FOR GARBAGE PICK-UP AND DISPOSAL OF THE TOWN OF MANSFIELD, WA.- Council member Lamar made a motion to accept, seconded by Bayless.

ORDINANCE #551-AMENDING CHAPTER 18.10 MANSFIELD MUNICIPAL CODE ZONING DEFINITIONS AND AMENDING CHAPTER 18.50 DISTRICT USE CHART AND ADDING A NEW CHAPTER 18.55 GENERAL REGULATIONS AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE-First read.

SHERIFF CAILLE QUARTERLY REPORT- Sheriff Caille presented to council to discuss changes at the Sheriff's Department and answer any questions council may have. Discussion took place on flock cameras, unlicensed vehicles, parking issues, and budget.

MAYOR'S REPORT-

Mayor Wall addressed guest Keith Siebert to see if would like to speak. He stated he was at the meeting to observe.

Supt. Doyal reported to council on maintenance that has taken place this month. Framing of the City Shop is underway.

Mayor Wall informed council that he has spoken with the City of Chelan regarding the playground equipment for surplus. Mayor Wall negotiated a price of \$750.00. Mayor Wall has meeting scheduled for next week with CIAW to go over parks and equipment. Council members Tupling and Lester will go pick up the playground equipment. Clerk Sima will work on a grant for placement and safety.

Council Lester presented a cost estimate of swing set parts for Triangle Park. Clerk Sima will submit a grant application.
